at Amelia Community Theatre

SING. DANCE. PERFORM. In a highly theatrical & stylized way! Come learn songs, dances, teamwork, & musical theatre techniques. Show Choir: is a performance group combining singing with choreographed movement or dance, sometimes adding a thematic element to the show.

WHO: Show Choir is for 2nd-6th graders. Owners Devin & Elizabeth Clevenger alongside their hired teachers and/or volunteers will teach choreography, music, and all performance aspects.

WHERE: Rehearsals will take place at Amelia Community Theatre (ACT) 207/209 Cedar St. Fernandina Beach FL 32034 on the Main stage & in the Mainstage lobby.

WHEN: Rehearsals are every Tuesday & Thursday from 4:30pm-6:00pm. Drop-off no earlier than 4:15pm. Start Date Jan. 12, 2021. See Full Schedule on the next page. A ClevengerCreations employee must be present at drop-off.

FEES:

- Monthly Tuition: \$110 Due on the 1st of each month paid via secure online pay-portal.
- Costume Fee: \$75 per costume. 2 Costumes will be utilized. Children will be able to keep their costumes afterwards (may exclude certain accessories). Costume fees are due Monday Feb 15th via online invoice.
- Tan Jazz shoes for Girls, Black Jazz shoes for boys. Please purchase Jazz shoes for the start of class. Additional kinds of dance shoes may be requested (Tap Shoes, etc.)
- All Children will need nude underclothes/ dancewear to be worn underneath their costumes. An e-mail will be sent out closer to show dates to describe this need.
- Make-up Kit & Hairbrush. Hair supplies will be provided by CC.
 - Personal Make-up kit will require specific selections determined by CC. A general list of supplies detailed closer to showtime will include: specific brush set, foundation, powder, make-up sponges, blush, specific eye shadow palette (girls only), eyeliner, mascara, false eyelashes & glue (girls only), specific lipstick, make-up wipes, caboodle to carry make-up.
- Show Choir T-shirt \$20 due at registration: Students are required to wear this T-shirt as part of their uniform to every rehearsal. A uniformed polished feel/look in rehearsals creates a polished performer. Uniform Consists of:

Girls: Black leggings, black skorts, black skirts with shorts underneath. Girls may also opt to wear black tights, black leotard, & Showchoir tee over the top. Hair pulled up in high pony, secured tightly and with hairspray. A mask-not a face shield.

Guys: Black pants, black shorts, or black jazz pants. Hair should be out of face with gel or hair spray. Long hair should be secured with a hair tie.

TICKETS:

Tickets will be sold exclusively through ACT starting **March 30th @ 10:30am.**

- \$15 in person seats
- \$20 Livestream Ticket per household.
- Lap Children 5 & under- free when sitting on an adult's lap.
- In person seating is currently limited due to COVID-19. Please get your tickets early as we will not be able to accommodate more in person seating when the shows sell out.

Parents/Guardians:

1. One adult member of each household is expected to volunteer at least once during Tech Week/Show dates. ACT requires TWO ushers per show (One usher must sit in the lobby for the duration of the show). Hair/Make-up helpers will be needed prior to each show & during dress rehearsals. Other volunteer opportunities will become available.
2. If your child should have an issue arise in class, please kindly send an e-mail explaining your child's needs to ContactClevengerCreations@gmail.com. We are more than happy to assess and see how we can help. We will not meet before or after class, however we will be glad to schedule up to 3 parent/teacher conferences. Teachers have been instructed to walk away from any parent who yells or is coming from a place of aggression.
3. When signing up for this program please understand it is our intention & goal to have in person performances with a livestream option. If this is not possible due to COVID-19 or some other crazy scenario- CC will move the production online. Please only sign-up for this class if an online option is satisfactory to your needs.
4. If your child is sick or feeling unwell do not bring them to rehearsal. Parents MUST notify CC if a family member in your household has contracted COVID-19.

COVID-19

- CC has agreed to follow ACT's COVID-19 pre-cautions. Currently, these include but are not limited to the following:
 - Performers/Teachers must wear masks (not face shields) during rehearsals up until Final rehearsals & shows.
 - Masks must be worn backstage
 - All activities are subject to applicable laws & regulations
 - Should there be an outbreak of more than one household of participants or transmission of COVID-19 reasonably determined to have occurred at rehearsals, ACT may require up to a 14-day hiatus of rehearsals. In this case CC will provide at home learning materials, videos, or hold Zoom Class.
 - Participants will be socially distanced when reasonably possible while on site.
 - Children will be sent home if their temperature reads at or over 100.4.
 - Please check email before each rehearsal in the event teachers have contracted Covid-19 and rehearsal needs to be cancelled for the day.
